Maths

During Term 3, the students will continue to develop their mathematical skills in the following areas:

- Place Value
- Counting and Number
- Multiplication and Division
- Problem Solving & Open Ended Questions
- Area
- Fractions
- Volume & Capacity





Reading

During Term 3, the students will continue to develop their reading skills in the following areas:

- Using synthetic phonics to develop their phonics knowledge
- Decoding words using letter-sound knowledge
- Recognising High Frequency words
- Building their vocabulary
- Applying different reading strategies
- Answering comprehension questions

Writing

During Term 3, the students will continue to develop their writing skills in the following areas:

- Writing narratives and procedures
- Using THRASS and synthetic phonics to make the correct spelling choices
- Handwriting using correct formation
- Editing their work
- Publishing their work on dotted thirds paper and on laptops



Investigations

This term, our big question is 'How can we use chemistry to create art?'. The students will question:

- How can we combine materials to create different arts?
- How do First Nations use natural materials to create art?
- What are the different ways we can manipulate materials?
