

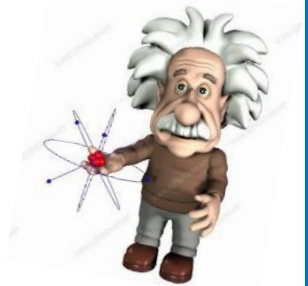


Thursday 12th September

On Tuesday we had the **Department's Education State Board** come to our school and observe the 3/4 Planning. During their visit, the Education Board got to observe students participating in the planning by sharing their ideas and exploring big questions about what they would like to explore during next term's investigation topic **I am a Historian!** The Education Board were very impressed with the students and their ideas for next term!

Next week is our **Design Expo** and this will allow students the opportunity to show their families some of the wonderful inventions and the great learning that has happened over the term.
