# **Maths**

This term, the 3/4 Learning
Community will be focussing on
learning effective strategies to
solve multiplication and division
problems. We will also be
exploring statistics and
probability, including correctly
creating graphs for data.

# Reading

This term, the 3/4 Learning
Community will be focussing on
the four key skills of 'Reciprocal
Teaching'. Students will develop
their predicting, clarifying,
summarising and questioning
skills while reading, as well as a
focus on comprehension.

# **Writing**

This term, the 3/4 Learning Community will be using the Cumulative Writing Cycle to write an informative Causal Explanation. Students will be learning about the process a volcano takes when it erupts and explaining the stages.

# **Investigations**

This term, our big question is 'How is our Earth an amazing resource?' Students will be exploring earth and space sciences and investigating a range of natural disasters. They will also be learning about renewable resources found on planet Earth.

# Administration & Reminders

### Uniform
