INVESTIGATIONS - I AM A BIOLOGIST

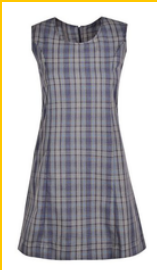
THIS TERM THE BIG QUESTION IS 'WHAT SUSTAINS THE CIRCLE OF LIFE?'
