The 3/4 students will enhance their mathematical abilities in these key

mathematical abilities in these key areas:

- Understanding numbers, including place value and counting.
- Strategies for multiplication and division, such as using groups of and arrays
- Exploring mass and capacity
 - Concepts of time

READING

The 3/4 students will enhance focus on developing their reading skills in the following areas:

 Making connections between the experiences of characters and the student's own experiences to build understanding

Applying strategies such as rereading, reading on and using context clues

Summarising texts and making predictions

Comprehending texts by answering questions

INVESTIGATIONS

The 3/4 students will investigate the following concepts relating to chemistry:

- States of matter
- How heat affects or changes the state of an object
- Purposes of different material
- Reusing, repurposing and recycling





The 3/4 students will develop their personal and interpersonal skills by exploring the following:

- the influence social situations have on emotional responses and behaviour
- strategies that enhance persistence and adaptability
- similarities and differences between individuals and groups based on different factors
- the benefits of collaboration and evaluation of collaboration skills

WRITING


The 3/4 students will develop their writing skills in the following areas:

- Writing Procedural Recounts and Classifying Report
- Including adjectives, noun groups, adverbial phrases, verbs (relating, auxiliary)
- Rereading and editing
- Publishing

AUSLAN

The 3/4 students will develop their communication skills by participating in an Auslan programs that involves:

- Learning the Auslan hand shapes
- Recapping the Auslan alphabet and greetings
- Learning Auslan signs that can be used through daily interactions
- Exploring signs related to school


