We want to thank all the parents who have shared their thoughts through our previous surveys and focus groups. Your voice is a vital piece of the puzzle! We look forward to sharing our review highlights and our future goals with you later this term.

Our school is about to conduct this year's **Parent / Caregiver / Guardian Opinion Survey** offered by the Department of Education and is seeking your feedback. The survey is designed to assist schools in gaining an understanding of families' perceptions of school climate, student behavior, and student engagement. The survey is optional, but we encourage and appreciate your participation.

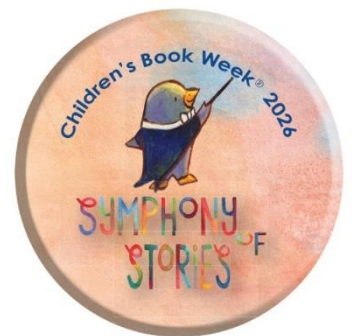
