## Thursday 14th August

Last Friday, the 3/4 Learning Community had an excursion to TwistED Science with a group of scientists. The workshop was titled 'State to States'. They learnt about the states of matter; solid, liquid and gas through hands-on activities.

The students conducted interesting experiments where they got to learn more about how matter undergoes the

processes of melting, condensation, evaporation and freezing to change


from one state to another.

Some of the experiments they did were -

 The Skittles Experiment which demonstrates states of matter and related concepts including diffusion and

concentration.

 The Water Tension Experiment which demonstrated how water is a liquid that can be



sucked into a pipette and put on an upside down

petri dish without flowing over the edge because of the water tension.

• The Fire Extinguisher Experiment which highlights how chemical



reactions that require sodium bicarbonate (solid) and vinegar (liquid) can produce carbon dioxide (gas) which disrupts the fire trio of fuel, oxygen and heat.
