How to access free dental care

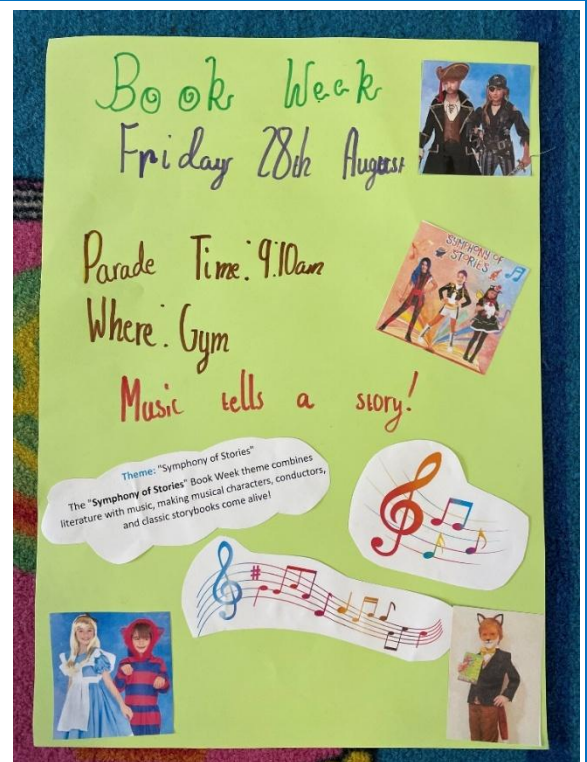
We need your consent before they can provide services. Consent is usually provided by a parent or guardian.
