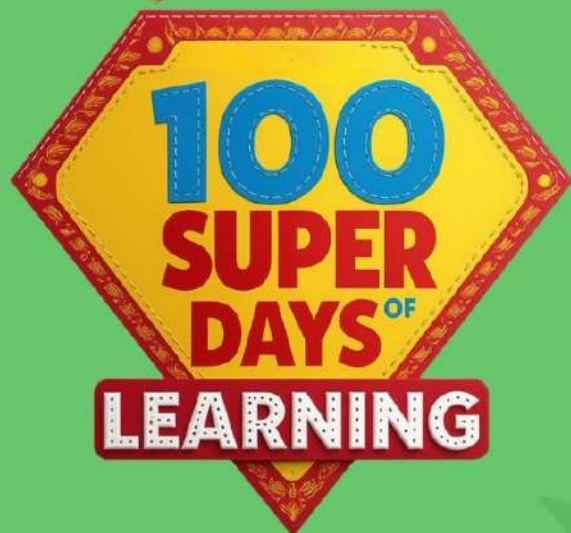

LEARNING FOCUS TERM 3

MATHEMATICS



In Term 3, students will be working towards:

- recognising, naming, ordering and writing numbers.
- counting forwards and backwards to 100.
- making 2 digit numbers using concrete materials.
- exploring mass and length .
- addition and subtraction



READING

During Term 3, students will be learning to:

- decode words in books.
- identify common letter sounds.
- develop oral language skills.
- blend CVC words.
- use comprehension skills.
- read high frequency words.



WRITING

During Writing, students will be working towards:

- forming all upper and lower case letters correctly.
- writing dominant sounds in words.
- writing sentences using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.
- constructing narratives including writing the orientation, complication and conclusion.



INVESTIGATIONS

This term, students will be exploring the topic **I am a geologist**. Within this topic, students will be asking the big question 'How can I be a scientist every day?'

Students will explore:

- the seven senses
- how we use our senses to understand the world.
- how we use our senses to care for the world.
- why we should we protect the earth's water, land and air.
