



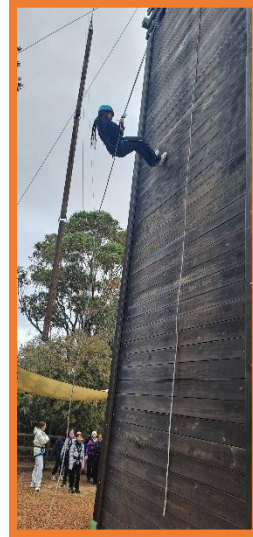
Last week, the 5/6 students went to PGL camp in Kyneton and got to participate in lots of fun and exciting activities.

On the first day, the students had a go at abseiling and a challenge course. In abseiling, students learned about the different safety



equipment like harnesses and carabiners.

They bravely climbed the staircase and had their equipment checked by an instructor before leaning back into their harness and walking down the abseiling tower backwards!



On the second day, the students had fun participating in the flying fox, the centipede climbing challenge, bushcraft and an indoor

laser tag competition. The centipede climbing challenge was made even more challenging because of the weather, but despite the rainy conditions, most students showed resilience by having a go! During the bushcraft activity, students learnt two useful knots; the figure eight knot, and the reef knot. They then tested their knot tying skills by creating shelters using ropes and tarps.



On the final day, the sun finally came out and the campers had a go at archery before braving the giant swing. Everyone had a great time at camp and all went home VERY tired!
