By next week I will hopefully be able to give you any arrangements and guidelines for next term.

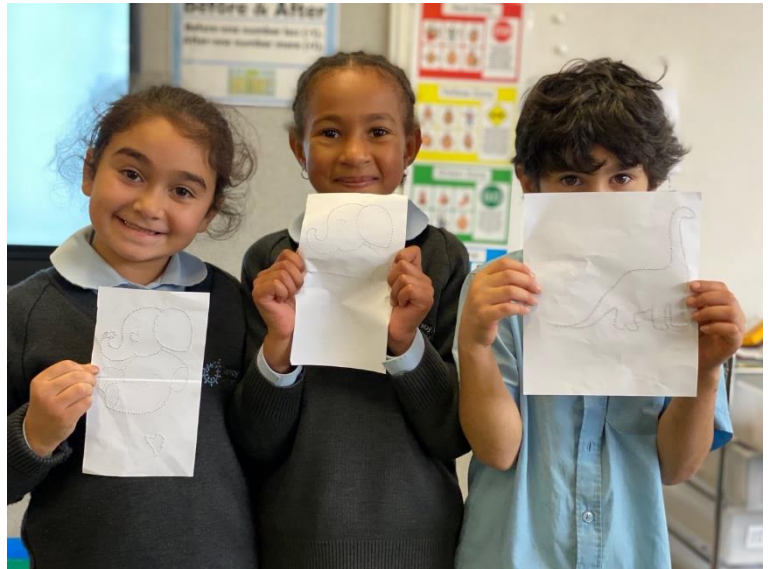
