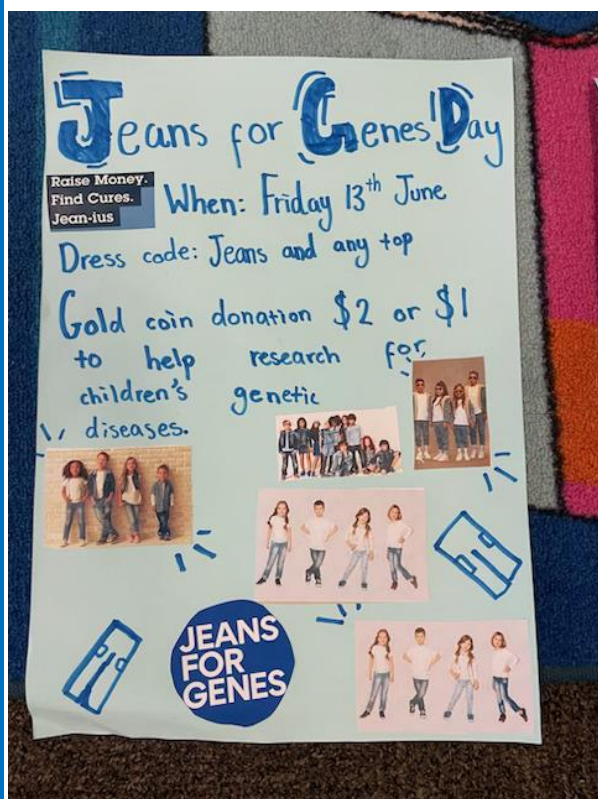
The school treats any personal information we gather from you confidentially and in line with the Department's Privacy Policy.
