


Newsletter 12 – 2025

Thursday 1st May

This term our investigations topic is 'I Am A Physicist' with each Learning Community focusing on a different area but with everybody focussing on inventions! This topic allows for lots of creativity as well as a lot of fun. It also involves the design skills of plan, draw, model and evaluate.

The **Foundation** students will be answering the question 'What can I invent with sound?' They will be heading off to hear many musical instruments that make a



The 1/2 Learning Community will be answering the question 'What can I invent using gravity?' They will be looking at the forces of gravity, push and pull. They will be exploring inventors and how things get invented through reading and discussing picture story books.

The 3/4 Learning Community will be answering the question 'What can I invent using heat and force? They will be exploring friction, magnets and electrostatic forces and look at ways this knowledge was used to create things.

The 5/6 Learning Community will be answering the question 'What can I invent using light and electricity?' They will be exploring the

> many sources of electricity, electrical


circuits as well as the refraction and reflection of light.


