On Tuesday, the 5/6 students went on an excursion to the Ricketts Point Marine Sanctuary in Beaumaris. The students were excited to explore the marine ecosystem that they have been learning about during Writing and Investigations sessions.

We had a hands-on look at sea animals and



were guided through their behaviour and adaptations by educators who were marine biologists. The students built on their knowledge of threats to marine life, including pollution and plastics in the ocean. Then they conducted

an exercise where they sifted sand and identified the main pollutants on the beach.

They took part in a sea snail census and discussed how living things have developed adaptations based on the movement of tides. They were also excited to use binoculars to bird watch and identified different bird species, the Crested Tern, Black White faced Heron and
