
Please note: The school yard is supervised from 8:45am each morning until 3:35pm each afternoon Monday to Friday.

SCHOOL SAVING BONUS REMINDER

Don't forget to use your one-off support of \$400 for eligible government school students from Prep to Year 12 in 2025. The SSB can be used for uniforms until **Monday 30 June 2025.**

Any funds remaining after 30 June 2025, including online voucher amounts that have not been redeemed, will become a credit to use on school activities. However, the credit will not be available on your family account at our school until late July.

To use any remaining SSB funds to cover the cost of school activities in July, please refer to the <u>SSB online system</u> and allocate the funds to school activities before 30 June 2025.
