Students met a real-life scientist named James and participated in a range of weather experiments including creating a cloud in a bottle, making snow and constructing a UV detector. The 1/2 Learning Community had a fantastic time and learned lots of interesting facts about the weather.



On Wednesday, the 5/6 Learning Community spent the day celebrating the many things they have learnt and discovered about space and astronomy during NASA Day.



The day began with a mission briefing before the students broke into their collaborative groups to solve a range of mathematical and cryptic problems in an escape room style activity. Then, they participated in some basic physical training playing "comets and asteroids" on the oval before refuelling during lunch.

After the break, the students (acting as space cadets) took part in three rotations. Space Quiz with Thom, Planet and Solar System Cookies with Crystal and Constellation Exploration with Alex

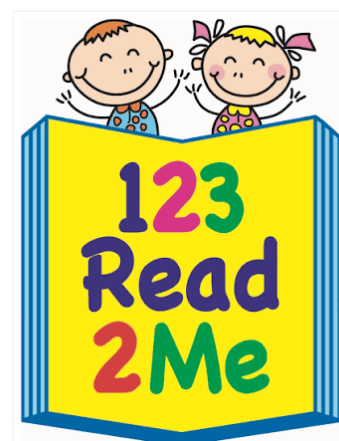
