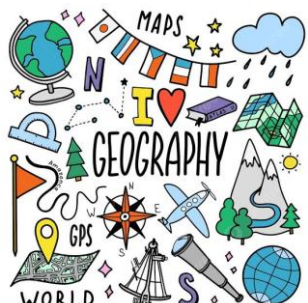


Thursday 17th September

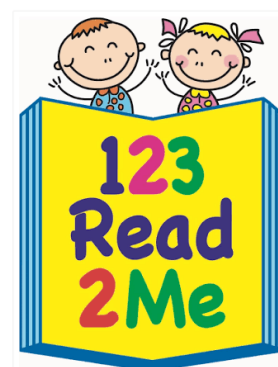
Coming up next term!
