YEAR 1/2

MATHEMATICS

This term, the Year 1/2s will be deepening their counting and place value skills. Students will also be focussing on the following:

- Australian Money
- Fractions
- Location and Tranformation
 - Time

READING

During this term, the Year 1/2s will be working on answering comprehension questions about the books they read.

Students will be answering literal, inferential and reorganisational questions. They will also be working on understanding the meaning of unfamiliar words they read to build their vocabulary.

WRITING

This term, the Year 1/2s will be writing Narrative texts, Poems and Persuasive discussions. Students will also be working on their editing skills to improve their writing.



INVESTIGATIONS

The Year 1/2 Students will be focussing on the topic 'I am an explorer!' They will be investigating the big question 'Where can a map take you?' Students will work in their collaborative groups to build their knowledge about different maps and identify the states and territories of Australia.
